- The school conducts various orientation programmes for our teachers to update themselves with the changes.

- The session on Identifying Stress and empowering students, Teacher –students Relationship was conducted by our school counselor.

- Our School feels proud and congratulates its Alumnus-Krishna S R, who is an All-India NEET topper in 2022-23. He topped as 8<sup>th</sup> ranker in AIR.
- SViS feels proud and accomplished in announcing the results of IIT –JEE 1<sup>st</sup> Main – Jan 2023 of our XII students. Ashok Narayan topped with 99.66 percentile, A.M. Selvaganesh stood second with 91.71 percentile and Srinithi stood third with 90.58 percentile. We wish them good luck to perform well in 2<sup>nd</sup> JEE Main and advanced level.

- Our school students participated in the Cluster VI Athletic meet conducted at Rajaji Bhavans vidyamandir, Chennai from 4th to 7th December 2022.
- Our school won laurels at the athletic meet conducted by the Hosur sahodaya Athletic Meet at Rockford school, Hosur on 29th October. 35 students participated from our school, we received 22 medals- 8 gold medals, 7 silver medals and 7 bronze medals. A total of 12 schools competed for the athletic meet.
- Our students participated and stood second in hand ball match for girls under 14 years at Shishya school, Hosur on 11th November 2022
- Health and Physical Education classes are conducted as per CBSE norms.
- In addition, sports competitions are conducted class wise and house wise
- Every week Friday and Saturday, Special coaching is imparted in Foot ball for students of class III to IX. Yoga is an integral part of the sports activities and are imparted to all students.
- Special days like world Environmental day, International Yoga Day, Fruit Day, Fit India Movement, Poshan Abhiyan, Earth Day, World Education Day, Unity Day, National education day, World AIDS day, National Science Day, Mathematics Day are celebrated at our school to teach the importance of the day, foster cultural appreciation and social awareness beyond textbooks.
  - **Independence Day celebration:** Independence Day was celebrated with active participation of the entire Siddharth village community. The day started with the welcoming of the chief guest followed by the march past by the four houses. Four groups joined to put up a fabulous show on Independence Day
  - **Experiential learning:** It is a great way to enjoy the unique learning experiences outside the classroom environment. Experiential learning helps us to experience hands on learning and provide us with the real world experience.
  - The students from classes I to IX were taken to super market, veterinary hospital, fire station, cultivation field, gerbera green garden, Bank etc.
  - The students from Classes I to XI were taken for an educational trip to Bannerghatta national park, Museum, Planetarium, CS grand theme park, Mysore, Kerala and Hyderabad
  - The students of Class X and XII organized the Teacher's day celebration to express their gratitude and appreciation by greeting all the teachers with hand- made greeting cards.
  - The school conducts many competitive exams like Asset and Olympiad to self-evaluate the performance of students in par with the National level
  - Some of the students were selected for the national level
  - The students are also exposed to CBSE online competitions. ArybhataGanit challenge 2022 was conducted for classes IV to X students to promote Mathematical and reasoning activities.

  - **Sport Day:** The annual sports meet of 2022 was held on 18<sup>th</sup> of November 2022. Various team games and athletic events were conducted. All the students enthusiastically participated.
